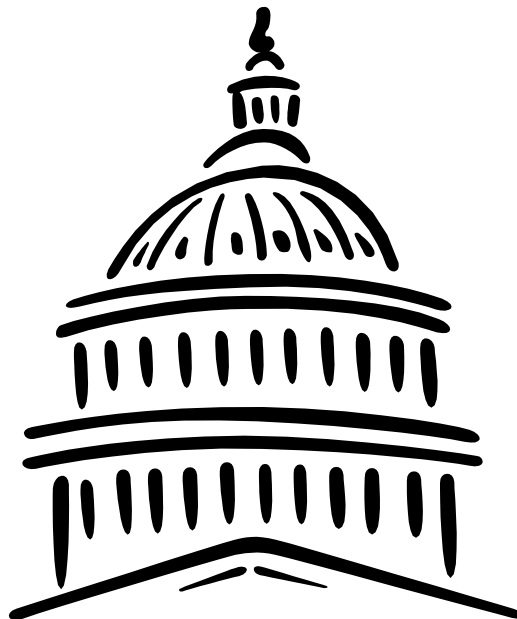

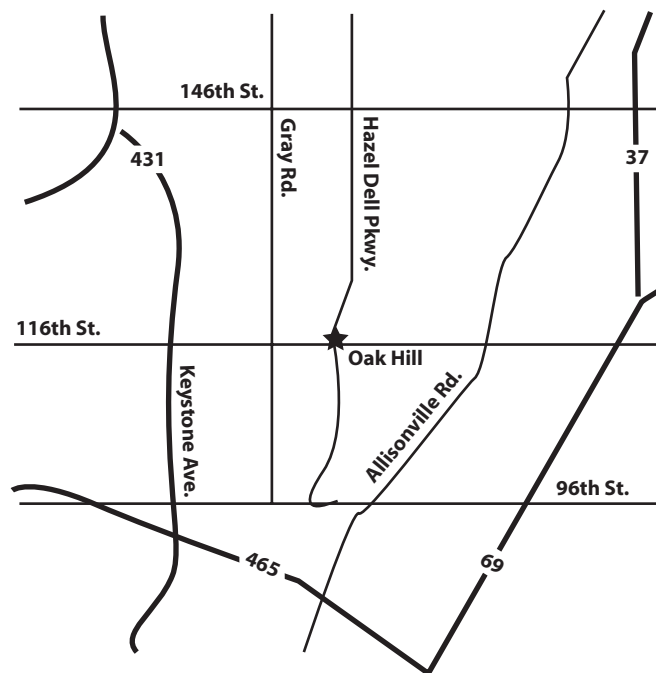

The Mansion at Oak Hill is located just 5 minutes north of I-465 at the corner of 116th Street and Hazel Dell Parkway and is very convenient to the towns of Carmel, Fishers and Noblesville as well as the northside of Indianapolis.

- From I-69, exit at 116th Street traveling west just 4 miles to The Mansion.
- From I-65 north, exit onto I-465 east to the Keystone Avenue exit. Travel north to 116th street and turn east just 2 miles to The Mansion.
- From I-65 south, exit onto I-465 east and travel to the north side of Indianapolis and exit onto Keystone Avenue north to 116th street. Turn east and travel just 2 miles to The Mansion.
- From US 31 north (Meridian Street), travel south to 116th Street and turn east and travel just 4 miles to The Mansion.

The ILF Legislative Committee would also like to honor Mrs. Harriet Stout as a friend to libraries. She is a former Women's Army Corps (WAC), and she served in the House representing Marion County from 1955-57. She was among few women serving at that time. During her tenure she sponsored a bill, HB 164, which amended public library law to allow gifts, donations, endowments, bequests or trusts to be kept in separate accounts and expended by the library board without appropriation. This was an important amendment of that era to aid libraries in securing and managing gift funds. Join us to thank Mrs. Stout for her efforts in supporting the library community!
