Description/Responsibilities: The Kendallville Public Library community seeks a director to provide progressive leadership in two beautiful, new libraries serving two small town/rural townships in pastoral Northeast Indiana. Our main, state-of-the-art facility commands a lovely view above the shores of Bixler Lake, signifying its singular importance in this community. Our Limberlost Branch is located in a small nearby lake community. Our new director will oversee a \$1 million dollar annual budget, lead a dynamic, creative, supportive staff (10 full-time; 11 part-time), and report to a seven-member board. The Kendallville and Rome City communities highly value the presence and mission of our libraries: eighty-five percent of our service population has library cards; we circulate 220,000 items per year and are members of Evergreen Indiana.

Qualifications: The successful candidate will have an MLS from an ALA accredited college or university; five years of professional supervisory experience; an Indiana Library Certification 2 or higher; and a valid Indiana driver's license
