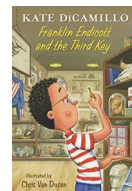
What Comes Next

Matt and Eric plan to sneak away during their band field trip to a comics convo. Without phones, cars or permission, the boys final adventure turns into a true bonding experience.



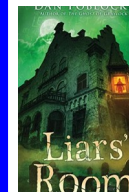
The Girl of the Southern Sea
