An alien unicorn, Bubble07, is given an important mission on Earth—should he and his fellow unicorns invade? To decide he poses as a stuffed


animal in a young Earthling Daughter's home.

Norman Didn't Do It (Yes, He Did) by Ryan Higgins


Norman the porcupine and Mildred the tree are best friends until one day the unexpected happens. What

The girl who lives here has never seen a ghost. What do they look like? White with holes for eyes? Can you even see them? Turn the pages as you help her search her haunted house for them!




Something's Wrong! A Bear, A Hare and Some Underwear by Jory John


The Year I Flew Away by Marie Arnold
